Capacity: 5 people

Minimum number of spaces required to book: All spaces must be booked (single party bookings only).

Hut or yurt rental seasons: Open year-round

Are dogs allowed? Yes, in summer only (due to melting snow in winter; no dogs)

Can customers arrange delivery of gear to hut or yurt? No (Guests may arrange their own gear drop off)

Winter water sources: Snowmelt (we have collecting/melting pots)

Driving to hut or yurt in summer: High-clearance 4 wheel drive accessibility

Summer water sources: No water source/guest must bring their own water (we have large containers that are also provided at each yurt)

Distance to summer water source(s): Not-applicable, no water source

Is there an outdoor fire ring in summer? Yes, with grate for outdoor cooking

Food options: Guests bring/prepare their own food

Refrigeration: No (in summer we provide a cooler and an outside food storage cabinet)

Are dishes, pots, pans, utensils, and cleaning supplies provided? Yes (well supplied)

Are propane burners for cooking provided? Yes, burners and propane are provided

Is there an oven? Yes, propane (propane provided)

Is there an outdoor grill? Yes, charcoal (bring your own charcoal)

Indoor heat source for hut or yurt: Wood-burning heat stove, wood provided

Outhouse/toilet information: Outhouse - no covered walkway, walk a short distance. Toilet paper provided.
