

High Camp Hut

Capacity: 14 (4 bedrooms, a loft and 3 beds in the main gathering room).

Comments/details about hut or yurt capacity: Located in a high alpine meadow at 11,000 feet looking off at spectacular mountains in the San Juans. The log cabin is large and spacious with many amenities including a wood-fired sauna and wood fired hot tub in the summer. There are 4 bedrooms, a loft and large living/dining area to spend time with family and friends!

Minimum number of spaces required to book: All spaces must be booked (single party bookings only). No matter how small or large your group you will be the only ones using the hut.

Hut or yurt rental seasons: Open year-round

Are dogs allowed? No

Can customers arrange delivery of gear to hut or yurt? Yes, for a fee - year-round.

Comments/details about delivery of gear: During the winter we use an old Tucker Sno-Cat to haul gear and in the summer we have an old Jeep with a trailer. We manage to carry all of your gear to the hut. Please do not pack anything heavier than 40 lbs so we can unload everything before you get to the hut!

Winter water sources: Well and Snowmelt

Comments/details about winter water sources: We have a well that we filter water into blue jugs for drinking water. Our well provides dish water in the winter and once it is filtered you can drink it. You do not have to haul water in! You can also melt snow if you like.

Driving to hut or yurt in summer: No vehicle access in summer. We do not allow people to drive on the access road to the cabin since we have to maintain the road. You will have to walk in, but we can transport your gear in for a reasonable fee!

Summer water sources: Spring, stream or lake, non-potable. We use spring water that we pump to a holding tank so there is running water to the cabin. For drinking water we filter this water and store it in blue drinking jugs. You do not need to bring your own water!

Distance to summer water source(s): Not-applicable, water source is on-site

Is there an outdoor fire ring in summer? Yes, no grate for outdoor cooking. There is a great fire ring to sit around with wonderful views. There is a gas grill for cooking!

Food options: Guests bring/prepare their own food

Food comments/details: We can give you menu ideas if so desired. We have a 4 burner cook stove with oven plus a gas grill on the deck.

Refrigeration: Yes, propane

Are dishes, pots, pans, utensils, and cleaning supplies provided? Yes. We provide paper plates and bowls to make cleaning up easier. Silverware and mugs are provided but must be hand cleaned and washed! Cleaning supplies and brooms are provided!

Are propane burners for cooking provided? Yes, burners and propane are provided. The stove is just like a regular stove at home with 4 burners and an oven.

Is there an oven? Yes, propane (propane provided)

Is there an outdoor grill? Yes, propane (propane provided)

Are guests allowed to bring their own grill? Yes (there is a grill already provided)

Indoor heat source for hut or yurt: Wood-burning, wood provided

Outhouse/toilet information: Outhouse - no covered walkway, walk a short distance. Toilet paper provided. We have 2 outhouses next to each other that are well stocked and clean!! They do not smell.

Bedding: Mattresses provided. Pillows provided. Bed linens (sheets and blankets) available to rent.

Cleaning the hut or yurt: Guests clean hut or yurt before departure. Guests carry-out their own trash (trashbags provided).

Lighting at hut or yurt: We have solar lights! They provide just enough light!

Wood-fired sauna: Yes, year-round. We have a wood fired sauna that is available all year round. There is also a wood fired hot tub in the summer. Wood provided.
