

SAN JUAN HUTS BIKE TOURS

These huts are only accessed as part of San Juan Huts Bike Tours – huts must be booked as a tour through the organization. Bike routes include Durango to Moab, Durango to Paradox, Telluride to Moab, or Telluride to Gateway.

In alphabetical order, the huts include: Black Mesa, Bolam Pass, Columbine, Dry Creek, Gateway, Graham Ranch, Gyser Pass, La Sal, Last Dollar Hut*, Paradox, Spring Creek and Wedding Bell. *The Last Dollar Hut is booked as part of the summer bike tours, but may also be booked by skiers in winter.

Summer water sources: Water is provided at the huts in 5 gallon jugs.

Distance to summer water source(s): Not-applicable, water source is on-site

Is there an outdoor fire ring in summer? No

Food options: Food stocking service is provided/guests prepare food (Bacon, eggs, cheese, butter, and tortillas are provided in coolers).

Refrigeration: Yes, stocked coolers

Are dishes, pots, pans, utensils, and cleaning supplies provided? Yes

Are propane burners for cooking provided? Yes, burners and propane are provided

Is there an oven? No

Is there an outdoor grill? No

Are guests allowed to bring their own grill? No

Indoor heat source for hut or yurt: **Wood-burning stoves, wood must be gathered.**

Outhouse/toilet information: Outhouse - no covered walkway, walk a short distance. Outhouses have composting toilets. Toilet paper provided.

Bedding: **Mattresses provided. Sleeping bags provided, guests must bring their own sleeping bag liner.**

Cleaning the hut or yurt: Guests clean hut or yurt before departure, trash service is provided.

Lighting at hut or yurt: Propane, propane provided
