Comments/details about hut or yurt capacity: 12 bunks arranged as such: 2 downstairs, 5 in common room upstairs (including one set of bunk beds), 2 double bunks in private rooms off main room, and 1 bunk in loft above main room

Minimum number of spaces required to book: All spaces must be booked (single party bookings only)

Hut or yurt rental seasons: Open year-round

Are dogs allowed? Yes, year-round

Can customers arrange delivery of gear to hut or yurt? No

Comments/details about gear delivery: This service is not provided by the hut, but winter guests sometimes make use of snowmobile shuttling services from Monarch Tours, located at the trailhead (<http://www.snowmobilemonarch.com>)

Winter water sources: Water is accessible year round from a mountain stream with access from a pipe off the trail near the hut.

Driving to hut or yurt in summer: High-clearance 4 wheel drive accessibility

Summer water sources: Water is accessible year round from a mountain stream with access from a pipe off the trail near the hut.

Distance to summer water source(s): Less than or equal to 1/4 mile

Is there an outdoor fire ring in summer? Yes, no grate for outdoor cooking

Food options: Guests bring/prepare their own food

Refrigeration: No

Are dishes, pots, pans, utensils, and cleaning supplies provided? Yes
